Submission Details

Proposals for papers should include the following:

- Presentation Title
- Presenter's Name(s) and Affiliation
- Sub-theme
- Abstracts which provide as much information in these areas:
 - Key issues to be addressed
 - Objective and scope of the presentation
 - Relevance of the presentation to the conference theme
 - Impact of the work and in particular, how can Caribbean HEIs gain from the research/presentation
 - Indicate type of research: survey, case study, historical analysis, theoretical exposition, exploratory paper

• Language: English

Length: At least 5 pages (excluding works cited/bibliography)

• Spacing: 1.5 lines

• Font: Times New Roman, 12 point

Margins: 2.5Word Citation style: APA

There are slots for eight-10 minutes presentations. These brief sessions expose attendees to new ideas, discoveries, challenges and solutions in higher education.
